Dear Parent/Carers

New Forest Trip Wednesday 24th May.

As part of our 'Can't see the Wood for the Trees' (New Forest) topic, Robins class are going for a guided walk at Whitefield Moor and visit to the New Forest Centre, Lyndhurst. This will enhance and support our learning about the local environment and wildlife. We will be travelling by minibus and staff car; we will depart and return within the normal school day.

There is a voluntary contribution of £5.00 per child for this trip. This contribution is voluntary and neither you nor your child will be treated differently if you do not pay. However, please note that without all such voluntary contributions, this visit **will** have to be cancelled, as the school is not in a position to provide further financial support. Children will need to bring a packed lunch for this trip. If your child receives Free School Meals we will automatically supply them with a school picnic; please let us know if you do not want this. If you normally pay for school lunches you will need to supply a packed lunch on this day (no glass bottles, fizzy drinks or sweets please). We will **not** be visiting the gift shop so please **do not** send your children with any additional money.

The children do not need to wear school uniform on this day. They should wear long trousers and long sleeved tops however to help prevent tics. They need sensible shoes or trainers, bearing in mind that they could well get dirty or muddy. It is always difficult to predict the English weather, so please make a judgement for yourselves and send warm/wet weather gear as appropriate. If it looks like sun, please make sure your child has had suncream applied, has a hat and brings plenty to drink.

There is no requirement for Parent/Carer signature on this letter as you kindly completed the annual 'Consent for school trips and off-site activities'. If there have been any changes to the consent form please inform the school office immediately.
