Strawberry Jelly topped with strawberries served with a mini shortbread finger supplied by Premier Foods

The flour for the fingers is milled in Hampshire and the jelly is produced in Kent.
Strawberries from New Forest Fruit supplied by local fruit and veg wholesalers
