The school photographer will be in school on Monday 17th September to take individual photos of the children as we need this for our records. Siblings in the school will be photographed as well as having their individual photos taken.

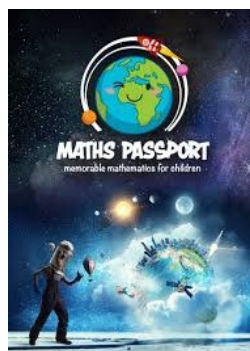
A family photo session will be available from 3:40pm—4:30pm located in the school gym. Photos will be taken in order of first come first served.
