- The children will draw characters and change their emotions and settings, keeping the original design features.

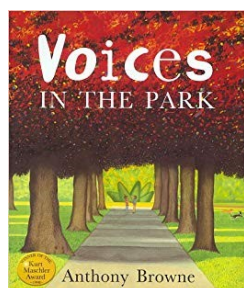
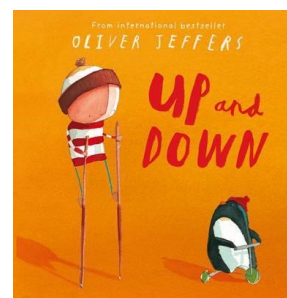
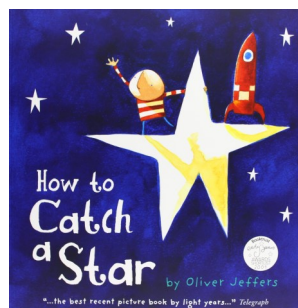
