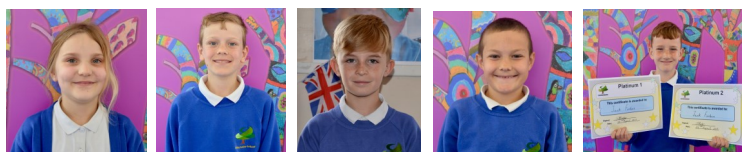

This month's subject is "9 Top Tips To Get Smart About Children's devices"

We would like to bring to your attention to a new phrase that young people are using mainly on Tik Tok and Spotify but not exclusively. This is IBF, which stands for Internet Best Friend or Internet Boyfriend. The phrase is used where children and young people arrange to meet up to film a video of their first meeting. This is obviously something to be aware of as parents and carers. These are meetings set up with someone your child has never met. That is the point. I cannot stress enough how unsafe this could potentially be for your child. Remember that an Internet Friend is not always who they say they are!
