## **Home Learning**

**Spelling:** spelling and sentence work will be set on a **Tuesday** for testing on **the following Tuesday**.

**Reading:** children are expected to read daily. They should then make a detailed written response in their reading journal at least three times a week. We shall be introducing new and exciting ways of presenting these in class over the coming weeks. Children who complete their reading journal regularly will receive raffle tickets for a chance to win a book.

**Maths:** home learning will include preparation for the Maths Passport as well as other activities such as Mathletics.

Please endeavour to provide your child with support and a suitable place to work. Should the home learning pose any difficulties at home, please consider taking advantage of the homework club which runs after school on a Wednesday. Please contact the office for further details.

## **PE and Games**

Although games and PE lessons will usually be on a Monday or a Wednesday, there may be changes in the timetable. We therefore ask you to ensure that your child has a named PE kit in school all the time (in a named bag).
