Year 3 Ancient Technology trip – Thursday 12th March 2020

As a part of our exciting topic 'Flintstone's Fun' the children will be studying British pre-history from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. We have organised an educational visit to 'The Ancient Technology Centre' at Cranborne, Dorset on Thursday 12th March 2020.

The children will have the opportunity to sample life in a pre-historic settlement, with activities such as textile weaving, fence building, farming and construction.

Due to the time of year we are going we ask children bring a winter coat, hat, scarf and gloves as the children may spend quite a lot of time outside. The trip may be messy so we recommend jogging bottoms with a school jumper/cardigan and shoes that you do not mind getting dirty - wellies or trainers.

We will be leaving school promptly at 9:00am and will return by the end of the school day. All the children will need to bring a small rucksack/bag with a home packed lunch (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles, preferably disposable wrappers rather than a lunchbox). If your child is entitled to a free school meal a packed lunch will be provided.

The cost of the trip is £20.20 per child this covers entrance and coach costs. Please make payment via the school office or your child's online account www.scopay.com by 20th February. If you wish to spread the amount, £10.00 can be made by January 31st and £10.20 by Thursday 20th February 2020. Although we can only ask that this is a voluntary contribution should there be insufficient contributions, the school reserves the right to cancel or postpone the visit.

We do hope you can support this venture, as the children will gain a valuable insight into how we used to live.
