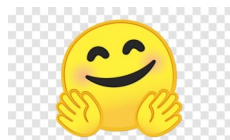

- Year 3—9.00am



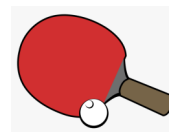
We will be providing some cordoned off areas for those who have to wait because they have children in multiple years.
