## **Year 5 Osmington Bay Residential Monday 6<sup>th</sup> – Friday 10<sup>th</sup> March 2023**

We have made a booking to visit PGL Osmington Bay in Dorset for a four night residential trip. This has been booked for Monday 6<sup>th</sup> to Friday 10<sup>th</sup> March 2023. Places are open to all pupils who will be in Year 5 in September 2022.

A presentation for pupils was held this morning in school. This was an opportunity for pupils to see a slide show of photographs of the venue and the activities available and to hear from teachers and pupils who have previously attended.

The cost of the trip is £327.85 per child. This includes coach travel, four nights' accommodation, all meals, activities and insurance.
